

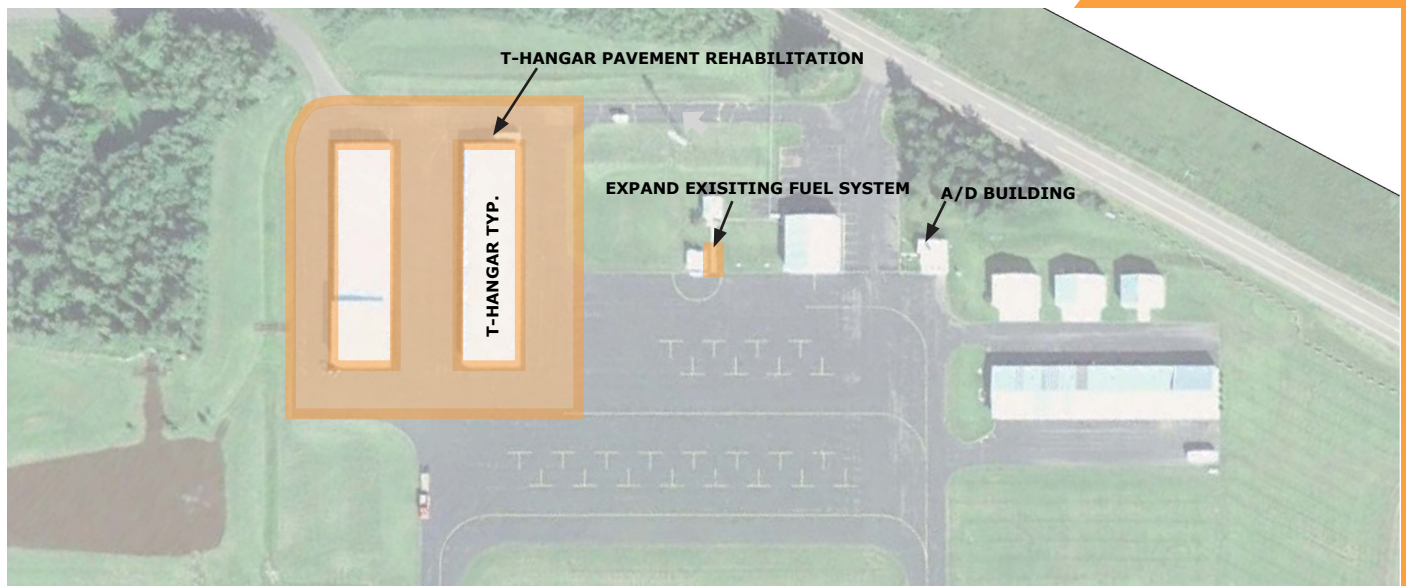

RICHARD B. HELGESON AIRPORT (TWM)—2018 AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Project Background

The airport will be completing two improvements in September and October of 2018. A new, aboveground Jet-A fuel tank will be installed adjacent to the existing 100-LL tank. We are anticipating both fuel systems to be unavailable for approximately one week around mid-October while the Jet-A system is installed.

The pavement adjacent to the T-hangars will also be replaced. Construction is projected to occur mid-September and last approximately 21 calendar days. Hangar access during construction will be limited.



SCHEDULE

Projects are scheduled to occur during September and October, 2018.

The T-Hangar pavement replacement will start in mid-September, and last approximately 21 calendar days.

The Jet-A fuel system installation will occur in mid-October.



CONSTRUCTION IMPACT

During the T-hangar pavement replacement, access to the T-hangars will be limited. All other pavements, including the runway, taxiway, and main apron will be unaffected.

Installation of the Jet-A system may require the unavailability of 100LL fuel.

Some temporary closures may be required and will be announced a minimum of 48 hours in advance by Notice to Airman (NOTAM).



FUNDING

This project is funded primarily by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT), and the City of Two Harbors.



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
