

# **2019 Streets & Alleys Improvement Project**

## **Alley North of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (2<sup>nd</sup> St to 3<sup>rd</sup> St):**

- The Contractor will be excavating the soils and rock from the alley and installing the Sand & Class-5. The Contractor is anticipating to be finished the excavating of the soils by this Thursday (08/29/2019).
- The Contractor will be pouring the West entrance alleyway apron on Wednesday (08/28/2019) The East end of the Alley will be accessible for the residents to use. Please stay off of the Apron at the West entrance once poured for 7 days to give the Apron the proper time needed to cure and gain strength.

## **Alley North of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (3<sup>rd</sup> St to 4<sup>th</sup> St):**

- The Contractor will be pouring the West entrance alleyway apron on Wednesday (08/28/2019) The East end will be accessible for residents to use. Please stay off of the Apron at the West entrance once poured for 7 days to give the Apron the proper time needed to cure and gain strength.

## **Alley North of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue (8<sup>th</sup> St to 9<sup>th</sup> St):**

- The contractor will be pouring the concrete driveways on Wednesday (08/28/2019) with weather permitting. If you have a concrete driveway and need to get a vehicle out, the contractor will be more than happy to assist you in getting out before the concrete is poured.

\*Please stay off of the concrete driveways once poured and painted white with cure for at least 5 days or until I post anew update informing you that you may drive on your new driveway. We have to wait for the lab results to come back for the concrete strength first. Once the lab results reach proper strength I will post an update letting you know.

## **Alley North of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue (8<sup>th</sup> St to 9<sup>th</sup> St):**

- The contractor will be pouring the concrete driveways on Wednesday (08/28/2019) with weather permitting. If you have a concrete driveway and need to get a vehicle out, the contractor will be more than happy to assist you in getting out before the concrete is poured.

\*Please stay off of the concrete driveways once poured and painted white with cure for at least 5 days or until I post anew update informing you that you may drive on your new driveway. We have to wait for the lab results to come back for the concrete strength first. Once the lab results reach proper strength. I will post an update letting you know.

## **9<sup>th</sup> Avenue / 15<sup>th</sup> St:**

- The contractor will be pouring some spot curb & gutter replacement panels on Wednesday (08/28/2019) with weather permitting. If the spot curb & gutter replacement panel is in your driveway the contractor will ramp some class-5 over the existing curb for you to be able to still access your driveway until the concrete has had 7 days to properly cure and gain the proper strength.
