### **New Business:**

1. Christine McCarthy gave us an update on the two recycling trailers that are available right now. Discussed having our own recycling dumpster at the campground. Christine will look at grants for the City to obtain a trailer, they cost \$37,000. We can park it temporarily at the campground, we just must schedule it with Lake Co. Recycling to make sure it's not competing with another event. Talked about the City's responsibility of possibly bringing to the recycling center and how often they would need to be serviced. Staff will continue to be in contact with Christine.
2. Resolution of support for 148th Fighter Wing- the Chamber's Military Affairs committee is leading an initiative to encourage Congress and military leadership in Washington D.C. to support the continued advancement of the base by identifying them as an appropriate recipient of a new F - 35 aircraft. The base provides an estimated 94 million annually of direct expenditure in the region. Motion for resolution of support by Woodruff, seconded by Rennwald.
3. Recycling in the City / downtown portable bathrooms to move to Public Works committee.
