Highway 61 in Two Harbors reduced to a single lane September 24–27

Duluth, Minn. – Motorists traveling through Two Harbors on Highway 61 at 6th Street will be restricted to a single lane, one direction at a time, controlled by a temporary signal Monday, September 24 through Thursday, September 27. The single lane section is only a few hundred feet long at 6th Street.

The traffic restriction is necessary as crews work on a deep storm sewer pipe. Temporary concrete barrier will separate traffic from the work area.

The 7th Street signal will be “flashing red”, functioning as a stop sign. Access to downtown will be provided on 7th Street. The side streets at 6th Street will be closed during this time.
