

ORDINANCE NO. 86, SECOND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TWO HARBORS, MINNESOTA AMENDING SECTION 11 OF THE TWO HARBORS CITY CODE CONCERNING THE PERMITTING OF PUBLIC MARKETS AND MARKET STANDS IN THE CITY OF TWO HARBORS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TWO HARBORS DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Addition. The following is hereby added to Section 11.02. Definitions:

“Public Market and Market Stand– Outdoor markets and vendor stands open to the public including farmers markets, craft markets, flea markets, and vendors of other miscellaneous goods, utilizing temporary or permanent vendor stalls and other structures.

Section 2. Public markets and market stands engaged in activities of the type generally allowed in the zoning district and adhering to such conditions as may be required to ensure compatibility with surrounding properties shall be allowed in the “B-1” Highway Business District, “B-2” Central Business District, and “MUW” Mixed-Use Waterfront District

Section 3. Public markets and markets stands shall be allowed on properties in such districts listed above upon issuance of an administratively approved Public Market and Market Stand Permit to the property owner that will apply to all public markets and markets stands on such property for the calendar year.

Section 4. The City Council, may, by resolution, exempt events from obtaining a Public Market and Market Stand Permit (“Exempt Event”). Vendors participating in and during an Exempt Event, and only such vendors, are allowed in any zone district in which the Exempt Event is taking place.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective: (a) thirty (30) days after (1) its passage and (2) approval by the Mayor, and (b) upon its publication once in the legal newspaper for the City of Two Harbors.
