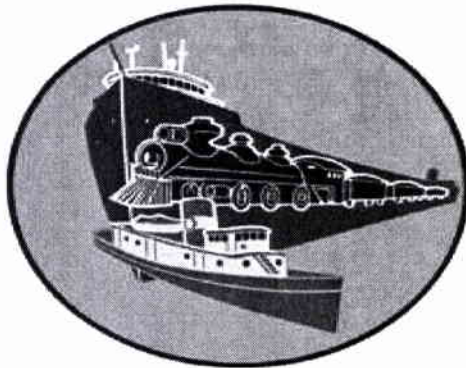
MONTHLY MAYOR'S COMMUNITY NIGHT
